



INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING PACHMAYR'S NEW ADJUSTABLE
TOP LO-SWING MOUNT

YOUR GUNSMITH CAN MAKE THIS INSTALLATION TO
HIS AND YOUR ENTIRE SATISFACTION

The new adjustable Pachmayr Top Lo-Swing Mount contains both windage and elevation adjustments. While it is possible to use a rifle telescope with fixed reticle, we highly recommend a scope to be used that contains both windage and elevation adjustments for easy final corrections.

1. Carefully place your rifle in a vise with soft jaws, if possible, to hold securely. Position base portion of the Pachmayr Mount on top of the rifle receiver and tighten down screws. Next, attach top half of the mount to the base and tighten fingerwheel until cones are in positive contact. Install the rifle scope in upper half of the mount and check to see that the reticle is properly centered in the scope and that the scope is positioned for correct eye relief.
2. Remove the bolt from the receiver, then bore sight at a small object 25 to 50 yards away. Should your rifle be automatic, slide, or lever action type, then a mirror or a bore sighting device should be used. Place a screwdriver at each end of Point C1 and C2. Rotate in either direction slowly while looking through the rifle scope until the scope reticle positions itself at the bore sight of the object. Setscrews F & F should then be tightened securely. Should you now find that one of the stop pins in the upper half of the mount is not resting on the receiver, you should file the pins down until both are in even contact with the base. USE CAUTION IN FILING, NOT TO REMOVE TOO MUCH METAL.
3. Final Adjustment. With top half of the mount and rifle scope down on the receiver in shooting position and fingerwheel turned fingertip tight until cones are in proper contact, adjust hold down spring so the point of spring barely wraps over the steel pin. Then turn setscrew up tightly on the collar holding the spring. Any further adjustments required in sighting the rifle to shoot to the point of aim should be done by the final use of windage and elevation dials in your rifle scope.

NOTE: Major parts of the new Pachmayr Adjustable Top Lo-Swing Scope Mount are not interchangeable with the older style side type of Lo-Swing Mount.
