WEAVER SCOPES



- 1. Achromatic lens system consisting of seven lens elements.

The four power Model B4 and six power B6 Scopes were developed especially for .22 rim fire rifles, Hornets, Bees and similar calibers. The B Models are of improved design and replace the Model G Weaver Scopes. The design, mechanically and optically, is a modern development and superior to any formerly used in .22 scopes. The B Models are light, compact with excellent optical qualities.

OPTICAL SYSTEM

The optical systems have seven lens elements and are achromatic, a feature not found in other scopes of this type. This lens system gives more light, sharper definition, clearer colors, and larger field of view than lens systems formerly used. Model B Scopes are limited to use on light recoil rifles because they are used a relatively short distance, about two inches, from the eye and not because of any lack of strength.

ADJUSTMENTS

Windage and elevation adjustments, of guaranteed accuracy, are internal and fully protected. The B Models have friction lock adjustments that are graduated and can be set with coin or cartridge rim. Windage and elevation movements are entirely independent and designed to give positive and exact sight changes with no play or lost motion. The B4 windage and elevation adjustments give a 1 inch sight change per graduation at 100 yards, and the B6 graduations ½ inch at 100 yards.

ACCURACY

B Model Scopes, while moderate in price, are actually precision instruments. Sturdy, compact construction makes the Model B a real hunting scope. The B4 has enough magnification for nearly all shooting but not too much for easy use offhand. It will make your shooting a lot more fun and a lot more effective whether it is just ordinary plinking or serious work at crows, hawks, squirrels, woodchucks, or jack rabbits. The B6 is somewhat of a specialized scope for use where most of the shots are at long range, from a rest or prone position.

WEAVER-MOUNTS FOR B SCOPES



TYPE N MOUNT is an attractive mount and is rigid and sturdy with plenty of strength as shown by the fact that it gives perfect results with Model J Scopes on high power rifles. It is pressed from tough alloy steel and its dependability has been proven under roughest use.



The Weaver Tip-Off Mount is specially made for .22 rifles with 3/8" dovetail grooves in the receivers of late model Savage, Stevens, Winchester, Marlin, Remington and Mossberg rifles. Clamp it on to the rifle or "Tip-off" instantly — without tools. Weaver B Scopes are aligned in the mount for immediate use. The mount drops into the receiver grooves, clamping screws are tightened with a coin and the rifle and scope are ready for sighting. Made of steel, the attractively proportioned, unusually strong and rigid Tip-Off Mount is perfectly adapted to the rifles for which it is especially designed.

Either the Type N or Tip-Off Mount is supplied as regular equipment with Model B Scopes at no extra cost when ordered with the Scope.

They can be used by those who prefer top mounts or the quick detachable feature in either top or side mounts. Weaver-Detachable Mounts use an entirely new V locating principle. V locating surfaces are combined with a wedging surface that binds the V's of the base and upper parts together to form a strong and rigid unit. These mounts were designed to withstand the recoil of high power rifles and are sturdy and dependable.
