MODEL K1 -- fastest sight of all

For Shotguns

- Extremely fast for all kinds of upland and wing shooting.
- Fast because there is only one sight, the large aiming dot, which is picked up instantly whether the eye is centered or not.
- The K1 simplifies shooting with both eyes open.
- Shows exact leads on cross flying game.
- Perfect for deer hunting in heavy woods using rifled slugs or buckshot.

For Rifles

- The fastest sight of all for rifles but more accurate than metallic sights.
- Only one sight to hold on the game; it is not necessary to align two sights.
- The K1 is the sight to use in woods and heavy cover.
- The clearness of both the target and crosshair will surprise the man who finds it hard to see iron sights.
- Fast, easy aiming for those unaccustomed to the magnification of most scopes.

The K1 Scope shows all objects in natural size. This avoids the confusion that magnification of the target would cause in extremely fast shooting. It avoids, too, the tremor and jumping of the image in the scope which would make very fast and close shooting just about impossible. This tremor is found in all magnifying

optical instruments and is especially noticeable in binoculars and high power rifle scopes when used off-hand. Except for magnification, the K1 has the features found in most scopes—



- No blurring of either the sight or the target.
- No eye strain.
- The eye need not be centered or in direct line with the scope.

FAST—AND ACCURATE

The gun with the K1 Scope can be fired just as quickly as the shotgun without sights or the rifle with open sights, but there is a big difference in accuracy; aim taken with the scope is far more certain and definite. The fastest flying bird, the speediest running game can be caught at once in the scope, quickly enough even for snap shooting. The instant the gun is thrown to the shoulder the large aiming dot is seen and swung immediately to aiming position. The shooter knows exactly how he is holding and leading, helping him to make certain hits, shot after shot.

The K1 shows the gunner the exact point where the center of the shot pattern will strike. It shows him, too, the all-important facts-how he is swinging and leading-something the experienced gunner, as well as rifleman, will appreciate and which will quickly help the beginner to become a deadly shot.

FOR THE SHOTGUN

Experts say both eyes should be open for shotgun shooting. The target is usually moving fast and it is quicker and easier to judge its speed, direction, and distance with both eyes than it is with only one eye. With the K1, the shooting eye looks into the scope and sees both the target and the aiming dot. The other eye remains open and as it looks down the side of the gun, it also sees the target. Though aim is taken with the shooting eye, the game is seen with both eyes, which is as it should be, but which is often difficult with the usual sights.

Except for the conspicuous aiming dot, the shooter

is scarcely concious of using a scope; but because of the definite aiming point, judging lead and gun swing is accurate. After leads on crossing shots are found (leads may be one-fifth to one-half the distance from the dot to the edge of the scope field) the shooter leads accordingly and these shots become almost as easy as straightaways.

A shotgun without the K1 must be "cheeked" the same for every shot, i. e. the face must be placed in the same position on the stock. In shotgun shooting the aiming eye itself acts as a rear sight. If the eye position varies, aim will vary and this accounts for many "unaccountable" misses. With the scope, the eye can vary a half inch or more sideways, and four inches fore and aft. Just as long as the eye can see into the scope, aim will be accurate.

FOR THE RIFLE

The K1 is the fastest sight of all for rifles and at the same time is more accurate and easier to use than metallic sights. It is unbeatable for woods and brush shooting; for fast close shots at running game; or for any kind of big game hunting where most of the shooting is not over a hundred yards and none of it over two hundred. The man whose eves no longer focus clearly on metallic sights or who has shot all his life without a scope and is unaccustomed to magnification will find the K1 gives him ease and accuracy of aim never before experienced.

The tremendous field of view of the K1 shows objects in natural size, thus avoiding any confusion that magnification might cause in extremely fast shooting. There is only one sight to align and unlike ordinary sights both it and the target are clear and sharp, for all eyes, old or young.

WEAVER SPLIT-RING DETACHABLE MOUNTS

Weaver Split-Ring Detachable Top and Side Mounts are used for attaching the K1 Scope to the gun. Auto and pump shotguns use the Side Mount which allows quick scope removal, leaving the top of the gun clear. Detachable Top Mounts are used on double barrel guns (also on ribbed sin-







gles.) A special onepiece base is attached to the rib so the rib should have sufficient thickness for holding the base screws.

Either Top or Side Mounts can be used on most rifles. See our Mount Folder for a complete list of guns showing the mounts adapted to them.
